The NSC are pleased offer this match to shooters from Civilian Service Rifle, Gallery Rifle & Pistol and Target Shotgun communities. This inaugural 4-Gun match will consist of three competitions being shot on the Saturday and one on Sunday. You can, however, enter just Saturday or Sunday, but this will exclude you from the 4-Gun event winner's title.

Competitions, locations, firearms and ammunition requirements are: Saturday's competitions:

- ★ Target Shotgun (Section 1 or 2) on Butt Zero shooting 5 stages requiring 42 rounds of Birdshot.
- ★ GRSB on Melville, Bay E, requiring 86 rounds for the US NRA National Defence Match (modified for the UK)
- ★ Practical Rifle and GRCF (or LBP) on Short Siberia requiring 40 rounds for both firearms for The Urban Contact Assessment.

Sunday's competitions:

- ★ Practical (or Service) Optic Class Rifle on Century Range, requiring 116 rounds for the The NRA Methuen Cup (AM) and Match R1304-National Guard Infantry Individual Match.

If you would like to enter the inaugural 4 Gun Match at Bisley, please study Course of Fire available to download separately, complete and return the entry form and return to NSC with the appropriate fee.

CERTIFICATION - From 1st January 2009, every civilian shooting on a MoD range must carry a Certificate of Safety and Competence signed by the chairman of a club, which is affiliated to the NRA, and of which he/she is a member. Before being allowed to shoot, competitors must produce this certificate and their FAC. The Certificate of Safety and Competence does not apply to Section 2 Shotguns. Full details on this subject can be found on the NRA website.

DECLARATION - This MUST be signed by all competitors

I declare that:

1. I am not a prohibited person within the meaning of Section 21 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended).
2. I have never had a Firearm or Shotgun Certificate refused or revoked. (If you have, please enclose full details in a sealed envelope marked 'Confidential').
3. On the first day of the competition I will be aged fourteen years or over.
4. I meet at least one of the following conditions:
 - a. I hold a Firearm Certificate permitting me to use the firearms that I shall fire in this competition for target shooting.
 - b. I am a full member of a Home Office Approved Club, will be shooting as a full member of that club and will use any firearm for which I do not hold a Firearm Certificate only in accordance with the applicable exemptions to S1 Firearms Act 1968 as amended.
 - c. I will only shoot with airguns that are exempt from the requirements of S1 and S5 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended) and/or with shotguns falling within the limits of S2 Firearms Act 1968 (as amended).
5. I agree that results and classifications may be published on the internet or elsewhere. (Please note that only your name, competitor number, class and score will be posted.)
6. I agree to abide by the rules of the National Rifle Association and of the Meeting and I will accept the decisions of the Meeting Director and the Committee as final.
